Nova Scotia Assessment: Reading, Writing, and Mathematics in Grade 6

This assessment will be administered to our grade six students over 4-days in October.


This assessment includes the following:

- reading and writing tasks that reflect the end of grade 5 curriculum outcome expectations
- reading passages in the narrative, information, poetry/song, and visual text genres
- reading comprehension questions in selected response format
- reading comprehension questions that are designed to provide a broad range of challenge, thereby providing more information about individual student performance
- one letter writing task and one story writing task
- mathematics questions that reflect the end of grade 5 curriculum outcome expectations
- selected response (multiple choice) mathematics questions in all mathematics domains

Our students have been practicing these skills and will be writing the literacy sections on Oct. 4 and 5 and the math sections on Oct. 11 and 12. To prepare, we encourage our students to get a good night's sleep before writing, eat a healthy breakfast at home or from our breakfast program and to do their best work.
